Let us know how you're using your cards. Don't have cards or have run out? Let Mother Jill know; she'll gladly give you a supply of cards to share.

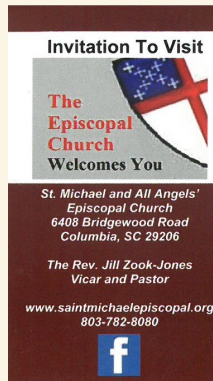
Join an Invite, Welcome or Connect team to invite, welcome or connect people to our congregation and to a relationship with God through Jesus Christ.

The Gospel: Mark 5:21-43



A woman finds healing by touching Jesus's cloak, and a girl is restored to life when he takes her by the hand. In both cases a boundary is crossed: in Jesus's time the hemorrhaging woman was considered ritually unclean, polluting others by her touch, and anyone who touched a corpse also became unclean. In Mark's gospel Jesus breaks down barriers, from his first meal at a tax collector's house to his last breath on the cross as the temple curtain is torn in two. We dare to touch Jesus in our "uncleanness" and to live as a community that defines no one as an outsider.
